

Provisional exchange guide

Question:

Do I see it right that at the backlights I simply have pull the white foil off a piece, then peel off the original LED strip and then stick the new LED strip?

Answer:

In principle yes. It may be that some also want to remove remains of glue, if they want to exchange it again.

The danger I noticed happens while lifting of the cover sheet. There easily is a kink in the cover foil, which one would later see through the display!

For pulling off the LED strip I take the outstanding FPC nose of the org. LED strip between thumb and index finger (thumb down for maximum force).

And first pull them up a bit high and then slowly until the whole strip has loosened. In order to keep the interspace between film and light body open, a pen or the like can be used by inserting it.

Now again thumb (left hand) or tool on the silver foil and again with the thumb and index finger (right hand) slowly remove the white LED strip from the silver adhesive foil. Remove the remains of glue (by petroleum), but not all the glue on the silver strip!

The new LED strip has its own adhesive tape on the side of the LEDs, which the org. strip didn't have.

This way you can place/glue the new LED strip directly into the recesses of the light body and there is no need to adjust around on the silver adhesive tape.

Hinge down the cover film and press on slightly in the area of the silver foil, done.
